# Fees. Entries & Other Information

#### Fees:

- 1. Pre-entry & Online: \$30/Warm Up \$30/Class \$55/Division
- 2. Post entry: \$35/Warm Up \$35/Class \$60/Division
- 3. Stall Fees: \$40 for the day (Contact show host for availability & reservations)
- 4. Return check fee: \$35 Regardless of reason.
- 5. Any fees not paid by close of show be assessed an additional \$25.
- 6. Non-showing fee for those who only wishing to school \$25
- 7. All fees payable to: Ellis Equestrian Services, LLC
- 8. We do not accept online payments or credit cards at this time.
- 9. Open checks are permitted and must be left with the show secretary.

#### How to Enter:

- 1. Visit the VBHSA website: www.vbhsa.org to enter online or download entry form.
- 2. Online entries and mailed entries must be received no later than 6:00pm the Thursday prior to the show.
- 3. VBHSA is not responsible for any mailed entries not received prior to show date.
- 4. Entry forms are accepted on day of show and must be presented to the show secretary.
- 5. Check in with the show secretary on day of show.
- 6. Please check out with show secretary for any fees owed.

### Parking:

- 1. Trailer/Vehicle parking may vary from one venue to another.
- 2. You may be directed at show location.
- 3. Regardless of venue, park car so as to not block trailers trying to get in or out.

### Cancellations:

 In the event the show may be cancelled, such as inclement weather, or other unforeseen event, a message will be posted on the VBHSA website and the VBHSA Facebook page.

Show Rules

#### Show Rules

- 1. All exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI protective helmets with harness fastened at all times while mounted on the show grounds.
- 2. Proper tack attire is required for all classes; Except as excused by the judge.
- 3. Judge's decision will be final. Talking to the judge is strictly prohibited.
- 4. All dogs MUST be on a leash and kept near trailer parking. Dogs are not allowed by the arena entry gate or concessions area,
- 5. All exhibitors must present and leave a paper copy with the show secretary of the negative Coggins.
- 6. All exhibitors must be checked in at the in-gate when the class is called.
- 7. Points are awarded in accordance with the VHSA point system.
- 8. Ribbons may be picked up by the show secretary stand.
- 9. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by management and their decision is final.

#### Condition of Entry

- Participants who submit an entry form realize and accept that any equine activity, sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. This is in accordance with the Virginia Equine Activity Liability Act 3.2-6200 thru 3.2-6203 of the Code of Virginia.
- 2. Show officials, venue employees will in no case be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, rider, guest, groom, attendant, or other employee, animal or equipment at the show, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the show management, and the facility harmless for any loss or accident to his or her horse(s) or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.
- 3. All guests and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damages they or their animals cause to show grounds.
- 4. In the event any exhibitor, agent, trainer fails to sign the entry form, their first entry onto the grounds shall be construed as acceptance of the rules of the show and the Show Venue.
- 5. Discourtesy to an official by any spectator, rider, trainer or groom will disqualify the horse(s) with which they are associated and all fees will be forfeited and you may be asked to leave the show venue.
- 6. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes or to reschedule classes and to interpret all questions and conditions in regards to or arising out of an incident at the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind.
