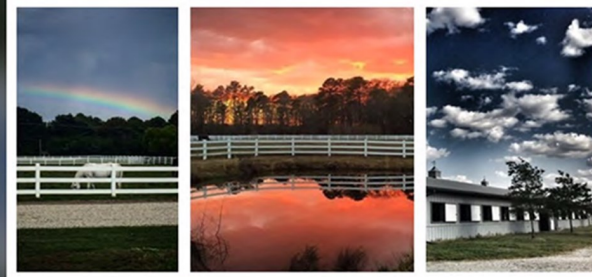

Applications are due back to a board member no later than Nov 1st, 2023.

The board will vote on a scholarship winner in late November or early December. The winner will be announced at the VBHSA end of show season awards banquet in January or February, 2024.

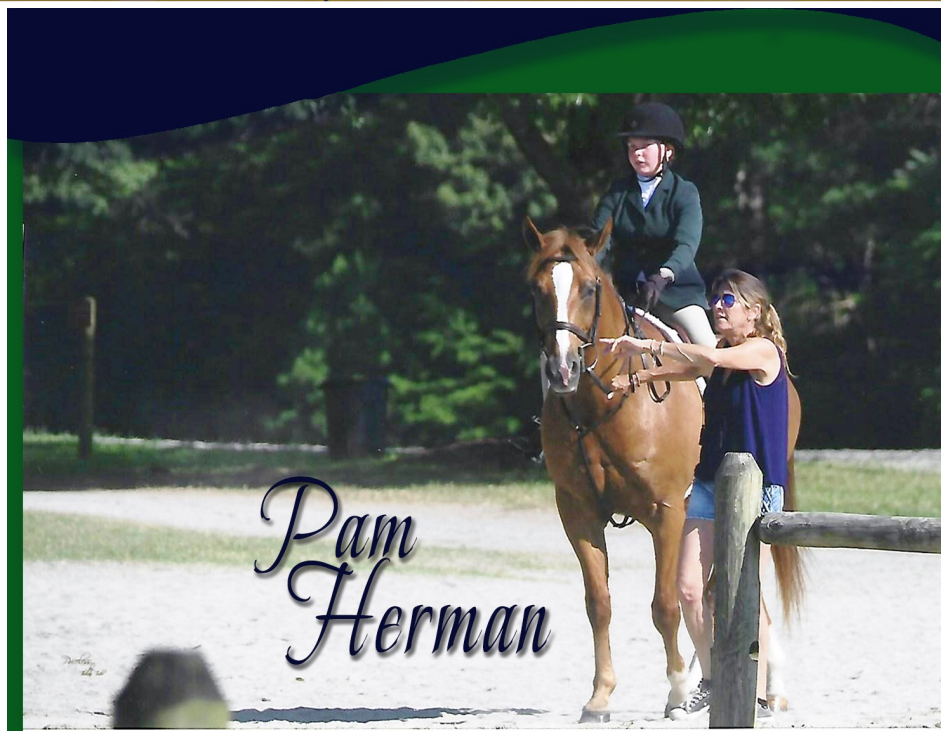

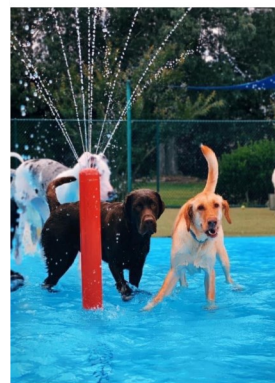
